Tech Tip

Fast Find

Fast Find saves search time by eliminating clicks and keystrokes. With the Fast Find field you can enter a character string applicable to a record's unique identifier, such as a work order number, and get immediate results.

The Fast Find field is located on the Navigation pane above the Action Menu on windows that include a required, unique identifier such as a sequential number or one-of-a-kind name, for example, PO number or Building name.

Typically, only one field is eligible for a Fast Find search. Simply hold your cursor over the field for a tool tip that lists the field or fields that are searched.

Type the character string, and press Enter.

If you enter a complete ID, WebTMA immediately opens the record.

If you enter a partial character string, WebTMA returns a Fast Find popup window that lists all records that contain the character string anywhere within the ID. Locate the desired record on the Fast Find popup, and double-click the line to open the record.
